Moved by Director Massaway, supported by Director Rickley, to approve the agenda as written.

Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Director Miller, supported by Director Hollowell, to suspend the rules and add the resolutions appointing Appellate Judges and an appointment to the Community Care Clinic.

Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Director Rickley, supported by Director Eitrem, to approve Res. 2011-136, Grant Application Approval Competitive Grant U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Community Transformation Grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes Lana Causley, Vice-Chairperson, to sign, negotiate, amend, and execute any agreements thereof for the Public Prevention Health Fund: Community Transformation Grant administered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Of which \$10,000 paid out in 2011 and \$10,000 to be paid out in 2012. The funding will be paid out of the Lansing office and this resolution modifies the budget accordingly.
