WHEREAS, the Seven Feathers Partnership, a community collaborative board of tribal and non Tribal partners, developed a Tribal Suicide Prevention Plan which was formally adopted on March 22,2011 (Resolution 2011-63); and

WHEREAS, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, a federal agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, is offering grants for up to five years to eligible states and tribes for the purpose of developing and implementing statewide or tribal youth suicide prevention and early intervention strategies, grounded in public/private collaboration.
