In Re: Enforcement of Foreign Court Judgments

Dear Madam/Sir:

Pursuant to Tribal Code Chapter 86, an Affidavit and Notice of Entry of Foreign Judgment must be completed and submitted for entry with this Court, along with a true or certified copy of the foreign court's judgment, and the \$20.00 filing fee. Upon receipt of same, we will notice the parties. After the 21 day waiting period has lapsed, and if no objections are filed, enforcement may begin.

For enforcement, Tribal Code Chapter 88, allows for requests and writs of garnishment to be filed using SCAO forms, identifying the correct court (SSM Chippewa Tribal Court) on each form and in accordance with Michigan Court Rule 3.101.

A copy of the Affidavit and Notice of Entry of Foreign Judgment is enclosed for your use. Photocopies may be made.
