

Martha Miller Tributary Scholarship



The Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians will be offering a \$1,000 scholarship to a Sault Tribal member who is working towards a degree in the field of Social Work, Social Services, or related human services field of study.

Qualifications:

- Must be an enrolled Sault Tribe member (copy of enrollment card required).
- Must be enrolled at a two- or four-year college or university working towards earning a degree (undergraduate or graduate degree).
- Must be full-time status.
- Must have submitted a Sault Tribe Higher Education Assistance Application and W-9 Taxpayer I.D. form for the 2010-2011 school year.
- Must submit a Cover Letter to include the following:
 - The name and location of the college or university you are attending.
 - The academic major you are pursuing.
 - The class level and number of credits you have completed.
 - Your career objective.
- Must submit a 300-500 word essay describing how the scholarship will help you realize your goals.
