6. I make this petition under the authority of Tribal Code Chapter 34, and ask the court to grant a personal protection order prohibiting the respondent from:

- Entering onto my/victim's residence and/or place of employment
- Assaulting, attacking, beating, molesting, or wounding me/victim
- Engaging or attempting to engage in domestic abuse against me/victim
- Following me/victim
- Contacting me/victim by any means, including by writing, telephone, other electronic means or by a third person
- Sending objects to me/victim
- Threatening to kill or physically injure me/victim
- Removing minor children from me/victim having legal custody of the children, except as otherwise authorized by a custody or parenting time order issued by a court of competent jurisdiction
- Purchasing or possessing a firearm or ammunition
- Interfering with my/victim's efforts to remove my/victim's children or personal property from premises that are solely owned or leased by the respondent to be restrained or enjoined
- Keeping, failing to surrender or concealing from me/victim the keys or other instruments necessary to maintain the security of my/victim's home
- Interfering with me/victim at my/victim's place of employment or education, or engaging in conduct that impairs my/victim's employment or educational relationship and environment
- Keeping, failing to surrender or concealing the vital records or financial instruments that belong to me/victim/my children
- Having access to information in records concerning a minor child of both me/victim and respondent that will inform respondent about the address or telephone number of the victim and the victim's minor child, or about the victim's employment address
- Engaging in stalking conduct
- Any other specific act or conduct that imposes upon or interferes with personal liberty or that causes a reasonable apprehension of domestic abuse, harassment, stalking or sexually inappropriate behavior
- Posting information and/or images on social media or other forms of communication with the intent to harass, annoy, intimidate, or embarrass me/victim, whether or not the petitioner has access to the information posted
- Approaching or appearing within 1500 feet of the victim
- Taking, transferring, encumbering, concealing, committing an act of cruelty or neglect upon, or otherwise disposing of any animal that is owned, possessed, leased, kept or held by the me/victim, the respondent, or a minor child residing in the residence or household of the petitioner or respondent.

7. I request an order be entered ex parte because immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will occur between now and a hearing or because notice itself will cause irreparable harm, loss or damage before the order can be entered.

8. If the court does not grant this petition ex parte, I do do not want to proceed on the petition. I understand that if I proceed on the petition a hearing will be held and all parties will be notified.
