- Install Owens-Corning Batt R-49 Unfaced Fiberglass Insulation (*equal or greater*) or blown in fiberglass entirely above ceiling deck insuring it covers the exterior wall area and does not interfere with any ventilation methods. Goal is to effectively reach energy reductions goals while cutting costs and carbon emissions. Progress pictures of installed insulation must be provided to STHA for every unit. Insulation density report will need to supplied for every unit if blown in fiberglass is used.
- The contractor is responsible for any interior damage during installation and must return to original condition
- Contractor is responsible for protecting the unit during the project from breakage or markings from falling debris.
- Properly dispose of all debris and any and all waste final clean up.
- Site must be free of any and all debris, daily.
- Progress pictures and density reports must be submitted for every unit with certified payroll.
