The Sault Tribe Purchasing Department will be accepting **SEALED BIDS** on behalf of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Odenaang Homes Tribal Enterprise Phase III- 2 Trailer Replacement Project # 24-076.

Scope of work:

- The project consists of Removal, Installation, and Transportation of Mobile Homes to be located in various lots in and around Sault Ste Marie and Brimley, Michigan. Work includes, but is not limited to, foundation construction, transportation, placement, utility connections, and all other work to establish occupancy of 11 mobile homes. Also includes providing ramp and/or landing access, along with the complete removal and disposal of 9 mobile homes and per the attached plans and specifications completed by UP Engineers & Architects.
