# AMENDING TRIBAL TAX CODE SECTION 43.504: DISTRIBUTION OF TAX PROCEEDS

## Administrative Office

43.805 Distribution of Hotel Use Tax Proceeds.

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The Tax Commission shall remit to the Tribe all hotel use tax proceeds from Hotels owned by the Tribe which are located within a one-quarter mile radius of a Licensed Gaming Establishment located on Tribal and Trust Lands, and the Tribe shall transfer such tax proceeds into the general fund. The Tax Commission shall remit to the Tribe all hotel use tax proceeds from Hotels which are not owned by the Tribe or are not located within a one quarter mile radius of a Licensed Gaming Establishment located on Tribal and Trust Lands, and the Tribe shall consolidate such proceeds quarterly, and the percentage of the proceeds retained by the Tribe under the Tax Agreement shall be transferred into the general fund. Of the total tax proceeds transferred to the general fund under this section, five cents out of every 12 cents (5/12) shall be earmarked to enhance educational and cultural purposes, to be dispersed evenly among the Five Units.
