EQUAL PROTECTIONS IN SAULT TRIBE VOTER REGISTRATION

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 U.S.C. 467 et seq; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article II, Section I of the Sault Tribe Constitution, the Board of Directors recognizes limitations in Tribal law, "subject to any limitation imposed by the laws of the United States"; and

WHEREAS, the 14th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution provides equal protections under the law to all U.S. citizens including those enrolled in Federally Recognized Tribes like the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 1 of the Sault Tribe Constitution states, "At fouryear intervals beginning four years from the year of adoption of this constitution, the board of directors shall cause to be made a census and voter registration of the membership within each unit and shall publish no less than three (3) months in advance of the next general election the results thereof"; and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 5 of the Sault Tribe Constitution states, "In any general election called pursuant to this constitution, each eligible voter shall vote within his unit of residence. Voters residing outside of any unit shall register not less than three months prior to any election and vote in the unit of their choice"; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.109 (1) of the Sault Tribe Election Ordinance provides that, "Any Member, eighteen (18) years of age or older on the date of the election as determined in Section 10.105 shall be eligible to register to participate as a voter in tribal elections"; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.109 (4) of the Sault Tribe Election Ordinance stipulates, "Resident Members shall automatically be registered within the election unit in which they maintain residency. Non-resident members shall select the election unit in which they will participate for election purposes. Registration forms must be filled out completely to become registered"; and

WHEREAS, automatically registering a segment of the Sault Tribe citizenship while requiring others to register may constitute an equal protections violation of the U.S. Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the solution to ensuring equal protection consistent with the 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution is to automatically register to vote all adult members (18 years of age and older) equally.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Board of Directors hereby amends Tribal Code Chapter 10 as follows:

10.109 Registration of Voters.

- (1) Any Member, eighteen (18) years of age or older on the date of the election as determined in Section 10.105 shall be automatically registered, by the Tribal Registrar, to participate as a voter in tribal elections.
- (2) The Tribal Registrar shall mail to all Adult Members a notice informing them of their status as registered voters with an option for those who reside outside of the service area to designate an Election Unit in which to vote.
- (3) Resident Members shall automatically be registered within the election unit in which they maintain residency. Non-resident members shall select their election unit of choice within ninety (90) days prior to the election on the form sent by the Tribal Registrar. Election Unit Registration forms, as indicated in (2) above, must be filled out completely to become registered within a unit.
- (4) Once a Member has been Registered, the Member's registration status is permanent and shall not change, subject to Subsection (3) and Subsection (5)
- (5) A resident member who loses their resident members status by moving out of an election unit must register pursuant to subsection (3).
- (6) Notwithstanding the section of the unit of choice in which to vote for Tribal Members residing outside of the Tribe's Election Units, all registered voters shall be eligible to vote in Tribal Elections and referenda not unit specific.
- (7) The Tribal Registrar shall prepare a roll of Registered voters and make available for inspection at least ninety (90) days prior to the election. This roll shall indicate the name, address, and Election Unit of each registered voter.
