SAULT STE. MARIE TRIBE OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM

Administered by Sault Tribe Housing Authority

THE PLAN

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Weatherization Program is to provide energy conservation improvements targeting features of owner-occupied homes that require repair/replacement to make the home more energy efficient. This program provides assistance to Sault Tribe households to improve their quality of life.

The program plan as written will remain in effect until such time a new or revised plan is presented to and approved by resolution of the Tribal Board of Directors.

ADMINISTRATION

GOAL:

The goal of the Sault Tribe Weatherization Program shall be to provide weatherization service to those Tribal Member homeowners, who have inadequate living conditions and are faced with costly repairs and/or replacement and to assist in obtaining self-sufficiency.

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the Sault Tribe Weatherization Program shall be to serve the neediest tribal families with energy conservation weatherization.

The objective will be reached by:

- a) Insuring that all tribal members have access to the program.
- b) Insuring that all applications will be processed within ten (10) business days.
- c) Insuring that all applications are processed according to program requirements and services listed in description of services.

SERVICE AREA

The service area shall include counties within the tribal service area. Those counties are Chippewa, Mackinac, Luce, Schoolcraft, Alger, Delta and Marquette.

SERVICE POPULATION

The population to be served shall be enrolled members of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians.

TYPE OF ACTIVITIES SUPPORTED

To remove issues of substandard weatherization in the home;

- a) that is not due to the fault of the applicant;
- b) that impedes or threatens the safety of the household;
- c) in which the household is not able to resolve the substandard weatherization with their own funds:

PRIORITIZED DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

Weatherization services include the following:

- 1. Roof repairs/replacement
- 2. Replacement of windows
- 3. Replacement of exterior doors
- 4. Insulating mobile home skirting
- 5. Sealing of basement openings and foundations
- 6. Insulating and air-sealing of the roof area/attic
- 7. Insulation/wrapping of pipes
- 8. Air-sealing measures, such as caulking and weather stripping
- 9. Venting (bathroom fans, dryers, range hood exhaust fans)
- 10. Energy efficient light fixtures and bulbs
- 11. Repair and efficiency modifications to central heating systems

EFFECTIVE DATE

May 1st - June 30th annually

STANDARD OF ASSISTANCE

Not to exceed \$5,0007,500 per applicant/household; eligible applicants may receive assistance no more than every 5 years.

Repairs/replacement that exceeds the \$5,0007,500 will be the sole responsibility of the applicant/household. All costs above the \$7,500 must be paid by applicant. If applicant cannot pay the additional cost, staff will assist in working with contractor to reduce the amount of the bid.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The application shall be completed in the name of the head of the household. 1.
- The applicant or his/her minor children shall be an enrolled member of the Sault Ste. 2. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians, or eligible for enrollment if less than 18 years of age.
- Applicant/household must reside in the seven county service area of Chippewa, 3. Draft 03/04/201403/08/16

Mackinac, Luce, Schoolcraft, Delta, Alger or Marquette. Proof of residency is required.

- 4. Applicant/household must meet current income guidelines. Applicants must provide proof of income for the entire household.
- 5. Income guidelines are based on the 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for the current FY Plan, adjusted for family size.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The applicant must provide written documentation proving legal ownership of property to be served.
- 2. All other Human Service agencies shall be contacted for an application of which the applicant may be eligible for assistance. All other forms of assistance or resources, such as insurance, savings or other means available are to be utilized for home weatherization first.

STANDARD OF SELECTION

- 1. The first 40-20 eligible applicants that have satisfied the application process will be scheduled for a Weatherization Inspection from the Sault Tribe Housing Authority Home Inspector or designee.
 - 2. Upon completion of the weatherization inspection a needs assessment will be completed.
 - 3. Selection will be based on the following:
 - a. Income
 - b. Need of Weatherization Services
 - c. Date of application, if there is a tie in points

EXCEPTIONS

This program does not offer exceptions to the written guidelines.

APPEAL

All determinations of assistance are final. This program does not offer a process to appeal a decision.
