ENDORSING HCR 15 AND URGING THE GOVERNOR AND ATTORNEY GENERAL TO TERMINATE THE ENBRIDGE EASEMENT AND SHUT DOWN LINE 5 UNDER THE STRAITS OF MACKINAC

WHEREAS, Enbridge Inc, a Canadian energy company, continues to operate a pipeline designated as Enbridge Line 5 that carries crude oil and natural gas liquids from Superior, Wisconsin, through Michigan to Sarnia, Ontario, Canada and includes an underwater stretch of pipeline that runs through the waters of the Straits of Mackinac directly below the Mackinac Bridge; and

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WHEREAS, Enbridge Line 5 is capable of carrying more than 20 million gallons of crude oil and natural gas liquids through the Straits of Mackinac each day; and

WHEREAS, despite the fact that its original design life was only 50 years, Enbridge Line 5 has now been in in operation for over 63 years; and

WHEREAS, a pipeline break or spill from any part of Line 5 would have catastrophic environmental impacts but a spill occurring in the Straits of Mackinac would be especially catastrophic, potentially causing billions of dollars of damage to the environment and to the local economy; and

WHEREAS, the impact of a pipeline break or spill is of particular concern to the Sault Tribe and its members because of the devastating effect it would have to the rights of its tribal members to engage in their treaty protected right to fish in those waters; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2015, the Board of Directors approved resolution 2015-45 opposing the continued operation of Enbridge Line 5 and demanding the decommissioning of that pipeline at the Straits of Mackinac; and

WHEREAS, State Representative Jeff Irwin, a Sault Tribe member, has introduced HCR 15, a proposed legislative joint resolution that would urge the Governor and the Attorney General to "exercise their authority to terminate the 1953 easement and shut down Enbridge Energy Line 5 under the Straits of Mackinac".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors hereby reaffirms its opposition to the continued operation of Enbridge Line 5 and renews its demand that the appropriate state and federal authorities move to immediately decommission Enbridge Line 5 under the Straits of Mackinac.
