WHEREAS, the purpose of the Indian Housing Block Grant Program – Competitive Grants (IHBG-C), is the development of viable Indian and Alaska Native communities, including the creation of decent housing, suitable living environments, and economic opportunities primarily for persons with low and moderate incomes; and

WHEREAS, the competitive funding will provide site work and infrastructure (water, sewer and electricity) and a minimum of six (6) additional rental units for low to moderate income tribal families in Hessel – two (2) units and Newberry – four (4) units; and

WHEREAS, the Sault Tribe Board of Directors appropriated four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to Unit 2 to accomplish new home purchases with Unit 2's area – Resolution 2022-154; and

WHEREAS, Unit 2 Directors are making a firm commitment of one million (\$1,000,000) of the four million (\$4,000,000) as a leveraged match to the overall 25% project match for the \$7.5M IHBG-C.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians concurs with and approves the firm commitment of \$1,000,000 of ARPA Fund Appropriation Unit 2 Housing funds.

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RESOLUTION NO: 2023-023

CLARIFYING 401(K) EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians ("Tribe") has adopted and maintains the Tribe's 401(k) Plan, originally effective as of January 1, 1998, as amended and restated effective as of May 1, 2009, and as thereafter amended from time to time ("Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has reserved the right to amend the Plan at any time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2017-08, the Tribe's Board of Directors ("Board of Directors") approved the reinstatement of a one percent (1%) match to the Plan, as a discretionary employer matching contribution, effective on January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2021-122, the Board of Directors approved an additional three percent (3%) discretionary employer contribution for all employees eligible under the terms of the Plan, effective on July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-306, the Board of Directors authorized an annual three percent (3%) employer contribution to the Plan, regardless of an employee's discretionary contribution to the Plan, to be implemented after an employee has been with the Tribe for at least one year of employment; and

WHEREAS, questions have arose as to the final percentages or determinations of employer contribution percentages following the approval of Resolution No. 2022-306 and the Board of Directors seeks to clarify the current authorized employer contributions under the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors hereby determines and clarifies that Resolution No. 2022-306 amended the Plan to change the three percent (3%) discretionary employer contribution created under Resolution No. 2021-122 into a three percent (3%) mandatory employer contribution into the Plan wherein all employees over the age of 18 will automatically receive an annual three percent (3%) employer contribution, without any discretionary contribution requirement, after an employee has been with the Tribe for at least one year of employment and completed one thousand (1,000) hours of service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors hereby determines and clarifies that Resolution No. 2022-306 did not negate or affect the one percent (1%) match to the Plan, contingent upon the employee contributing one percent (1%), as authorized under Resolution No. 2017-08.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the combination of the currently authorized employers contributions includes the three percent (3%) mandatory contribution, and one percent (1%) discretionary contribution, totaling a potential four percent (4%) employer contribution each year for employees over the age of 18 that have been with the Tribe for at least one year of employment and completed one thousand (1,000) hours of service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the terms of this Resolution hereby control, supersede, and amend any past Resolution that is contrary to the action of the Board of Directors set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors hereby authorizes and approves the Tribal Chairman, or designee, to execute any and all documents, including ancillary or supplemental documents or forms that do not change the substantive terms of the Plan as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the terms, conditions, and intent of this Resolution.

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RESOLUTION NO: 2023-024

RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS 2021-280 AND 2022-84 AND ARPA FUND REAPPROPRIATION FOR UNIT 1 FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians ("Tribe") Board of Directors previously appropriated eleven million dollars (\$11,000,000.00) of approved American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") funds via Resolutions 2021-280 and 2022-84 to enable Demawating Development to execute the Market Based Housing Development; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's Board of Directors now desires that this project be overseen by Sault Tribe Housing Authority, rather than Demawating Development, to execute an Affordable Housing Development Program ("Affordable Housing Development"), formerly named Market Based Housing Development, in order to assist its members in their recovery from the negative economic and public health impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby rescinds Resolutions 2021-280 and 2022-84.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution amends and supersedes any prior conflicting Resolution of the Board of Directors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Tribal enterprise named Odenaang Homes Tribal Enterprise, shall be created to execute Affordable Housing Development in place of Demawating Development.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Odenaang Homes Tribal Enterprise will be managed by the Sault Tribe Housing Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribe's Board of Directors now reappropriates the Eleven Million dollars (\$11,000,000.00) of UNIT 1 approved ARPA funds initially appropriated to Demawating Development to Odenaang Homes Tribal Enterprise to be managed by Sault Tribe Housing Authority in order to accomplish the Affordable Housing Development.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribe's Board of Directors authorizes the Sault Tribe Housing Authority Director to administratively establish a budget for the Affordable Housing Development.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors hereby authorizes and approves the Tribal Chairman, or designee, to execute any and all documents, including ancillary or supplemental documents or forms, as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the terms, conditions, and intent of this Resolution.
