9. SUBLEASE, ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER. Lessee may assign or Lease or sublease any part or the whole of the Real Property as permitted under applicable federal law. Any subleases, assignments or transfers shall be for the purposes set forth in this Lease, and shall not have a term extending beyond the term of this Lease, and do not require the BIA approval of the sub-lease or consent requirements. If required under applicable federal law, the Parties shall furnish the Bureau of Indian Affairs within thirty (30) days after execution an original or certified copy of the sublease, assignment or transfer for recordation.

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#### AUTHORIZATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS TRIBAL TRUST LAND TRIBAL SIDEWALKS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under the Indian Reorganized Act of 1934, 25 USC 467 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America holds land located in the City of Sault Ste. Marie in trust for the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Sault Tribe Transportation Program has requested an easement, without tenure, for the purpose of completing the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Road Project #F60-469SA TTP Routes 5205, 5600, 5200, 5201, 5202, 5203, 5204, 5300, 5301, 5302, 5304, and 5405.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Board of Directors hereby maintains its existing jurisdiction over the land, activities, and persons with the right-of-way, and this grant does not diminish to any extent: (a) the Tribe's power to tax the land, any improvements on the land, or any person or activity within the right-of-way; (b) the Tribe's authority to enforce law of general or particular application on the land subject to and with the right-of-way, as if there were no grant of right-of-way; (c) the Tribe's inherent sovereign power to exercise civil jurisdiction over non-members on Indian land; or (d) the character of the land subject to the right-of-way as Indian country under USC 1151.

BE IT FURTHER RESOVED, the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby approves the granting of a Right-of Way to the United States, Bureau of Indian Affairs, for no monetary consideration due to the overall benefits to the Tribe and its members, derived from the road improvement, across the following described property: See Attachment A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency is hereby requested to prepare and recommend approval of the right-of-way documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, should the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs decide to abandon the right-of-way, the right-of-way will automatically revert back to the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Board of Directors hereby approves and grants a right-of-way to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the Sidewalk Project and authorizes its Chairperson and Treasurer to execute any documentation required concerning this grant of right-or-way, for and on behalf of the Sault Ste. 

## DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death. It is caused by a new strain of coronavirus that had not been previously identified in

humans and can easily spread from person to person; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has been identified as the cause of an outbreak of respiratory illness first detected in Wuhan City, China. Person-to-person spread of the virus has occurred in the United States, with some of those occurring in people with no travel history and no known source of exposure. On January 31, the United States Department of Health and Human Services declared a public health emergency and on March 11, Governor Gretchen Whitmer declared a state of emergency in the State of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Directors has determined that a state of emergency exists on the Tribal reservation as well, and this Board of Director wishes to take all steps necessary to stem the spread of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a state of emergency is declared throughout the reservation lands of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the administration of the Casinos, the Tribal Government, the Health Division and the Law Enforcement Department, must coordinate and maximize all Tribal efforts that may be activated to resist the spread and injuries caused by the spread of COVID-19.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the state of emergency, the Executive Director of the Tribe, the Interim CEO of the Casinos, the Executive Director of EDC, shall have such authority as they deem necessary, to temporarily modify policies or procedures, order closures, cancel or schedule events, implement programs, and take all other appropriate steps, that they deem essential to the protection of the public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the state of emergency shall be terminated when emergency conditions no longer exist and appropriate programs have been implemented to recover from any effects of the emergency conditions, as determined by the Executive Director of the Tribe, and the termination of this State of Emergency shall be reported to this Board of Directors at the next meeting following termination, for review.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Director shall make daily updates to the Board of Directors.
