If you did not hunt, gather, trap or fish in the previous year, please select the check box on the first page and move on to submitting the report.

If at any point in time a question does not apply to you, simply check the “No” circle and no data will be required.

For turkey harvest, please select the season and gender of the animal harvested using the drop-down boxes before entering the number. If you harvest the same gender of animal in the same season but from a different county, please use a separate line to record that.

For black bear and white-tailed deer, if you hunted but did not harvest an animal, please still include the information requested (i.e. days hunted, county and method). If you successfully harvested any animals, please use a separate line for each animal. You can create a new line by clicking the “+” button to the right of the table. If you need to remove a line, click the “-” button to the right of the table.

When you have completed the form, you may print it for your records using the “Print Form” button, or you can submit it electronically using one of the following methods.

- If you use a default email application, such as Outlook, clicking the submit button will automatically open a new email with the form attached and several pieces of information already included. You simply need to click “Send” and it will take care of the rest.
- If you use a web-based email client, such as Gmail or Yahoo! Mail, you will need to save the form by clicking “File” in the top left corner of the screen, and clicking “Save As...” in the drop-down menu. Select a location on your computer to save the document. Then open your web-based email client and create a new email. Address this email to fishharvestreport@saulttribe.net and attach your saved form before sending. Please make the subject “20XX Annual Inland Harvest Report” (replacing 20XX with current year) to make receiving and sorting these emails easier.
