AMENDING RESOLUTION 2009-179 RECOGNIZING ASSIGNMENT OF NATIONAL CITY NOTES TO PNC BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION AND

APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION OF AMENDMENT TO LETTER OF CREDIT AGREEMENT WITH PNC BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians (the "Tribe") is a federally recognized Indian Tribal Government organized under the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 2009-179 the Tribe authorized the Waiver of Immunity and consent to Waiver of Tribal Court Jurisdiction in favor of National City Bank Midwest; and

WHEREAS, since the date of that Resolution, National City Bank has been acquired by and merged into PNC Bank, National Association; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe currently has a Letter of Credit in the amount of \$2,071,289.64 with PNC Bank, National Association ("Letter of Credit") to satisfy the security requirement of the Michigan Employment Security Act for the Tribe Self-funded Unemployment Program. Bank fees associated with the Letter are 3% of the Letter amount (approximately \$63,937.31). Collateral for this Letter of Credit is currently the full faith and credit of the Tribe, the Kewadin Casino Lakefront Inn in St. Ignace and the Administration Complex at 523/531 Ashmun, Sault Ste. Marie; and

WHEREAS, as part of the continuing status of the ongoing Unemployment Compensation Line of Credit, the Tribe must reaffirm that the Waivers of Immunity and Consent to Waiver of Tribal Court Jurisdiction contained in Resolution 2009-179 also flow in favor of PNC Bank, National Association; and

WHEREAS, the form of the Application for Amendment to Standby Letter of Credit with PNC Bank, National Association including Exhibit "A" attached thereto, which reaffirms the waivers of immunity and consent to waiver of Tribal Court jurisdiction contained in Resolution 2009-179 (collectively, the "Amendment Application") has been delivered to the Tribe and is approved by the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes in accordance with the Amendment Application to amend this Line of Credit for an increase in financing from PNC Bank, National Association in the amount of \$30,760 to bring the required security for the unemployment program up to the mandatory \$2,102,048.64 per the attached letter for the Unemployment Insurance Agency.
