ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2025-1

(Revising 2016-1)

On order of the Court, effective immediately, revises Administrative Order 2016-1, and states that the Sault Ste. Marie Chippewa Tribal Court allows for the electronic filing ("e-filing") of any pleading, motion, brief, response, lists, order, judgment or notice in any criminal, juvenile delinquency and child welfare proceedings. The Court may choose not to accept specific discovery materials such as extremely large videos, documents, medical records, etc.

E-filings must be submitted through email to <u>tswan@saulttribe.net</u>. and will be considered filed with the Tribal Court Clerk.

A document filed electronically shall be considered filed when the transmission is complete. Transmissions must be completed not later than 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, to be considered filed on the same day submitted.

The Court will not accept e-filings of any discovery materials or evidence, such as case service plans, court summaries, incident reports, etc.

Transmissions must be completed not later than 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday excluding holidays, to be considered filed on the same day submitted.
